FRANK Afternoon Blend

A FRANK exclusive. A blend of Darjeeling and three Sri Lankan Estate black teas as well as two Chinese green teas lightly accented with jasmine, Italian oil of bergamot and grapefruit peel.

FRANK Chef's Blend

FRANK's unique blend of black teas from China, Sri Lanka and India, blended with a touch of peach, spice, Chinese herbs and chrysanthemum petals.

FRANK Campfire Blend

Another FRANK exclusive. This smoky blend of Chinese, Indian and Ceylon teas is reminiscent of the old 'Caravan' blends. Especially popular for lovers of Lapsang Souchong (Winston Churchill's favorite tea).

Lung Ching, Dragon's Well

This classic green tea from the West Lake region of China is wok fired giving a toasty and slightly earthy note to the lightly sweet, nutty and vegetal tea.

Big Red Robe, Da Hong Pao

This historic Oolong from the rocky cliffs of Wuyishan in China (the birthplace of tea) is deeply roasted with a beautiful mineral finish exhibiting notes of caramelized fruit and cocoa nibs.

Makaibari Estate 1st Flush Darjeeling

This tea from India exhibits a lightly lemony, floral and greenish flavor profile with hints of malt and moderate tannins. Makaibari was the very first garden to be planted in Darjeeling and the first in India to become Organic and Bio-dynamic.

Idalgashina Estate Green Tea

From the UVA growing region of Sri Lanka. Light and fruity with a touch of sweetness.

Turmeric Lemon Apple (Herbal Tea)

Lemon fragrance, apples and the zest of turmeric

South African Rooibos (Herbal Tea)

Ginger, cinnamon, licorice root, black pepper, cardamom and flower petals.
